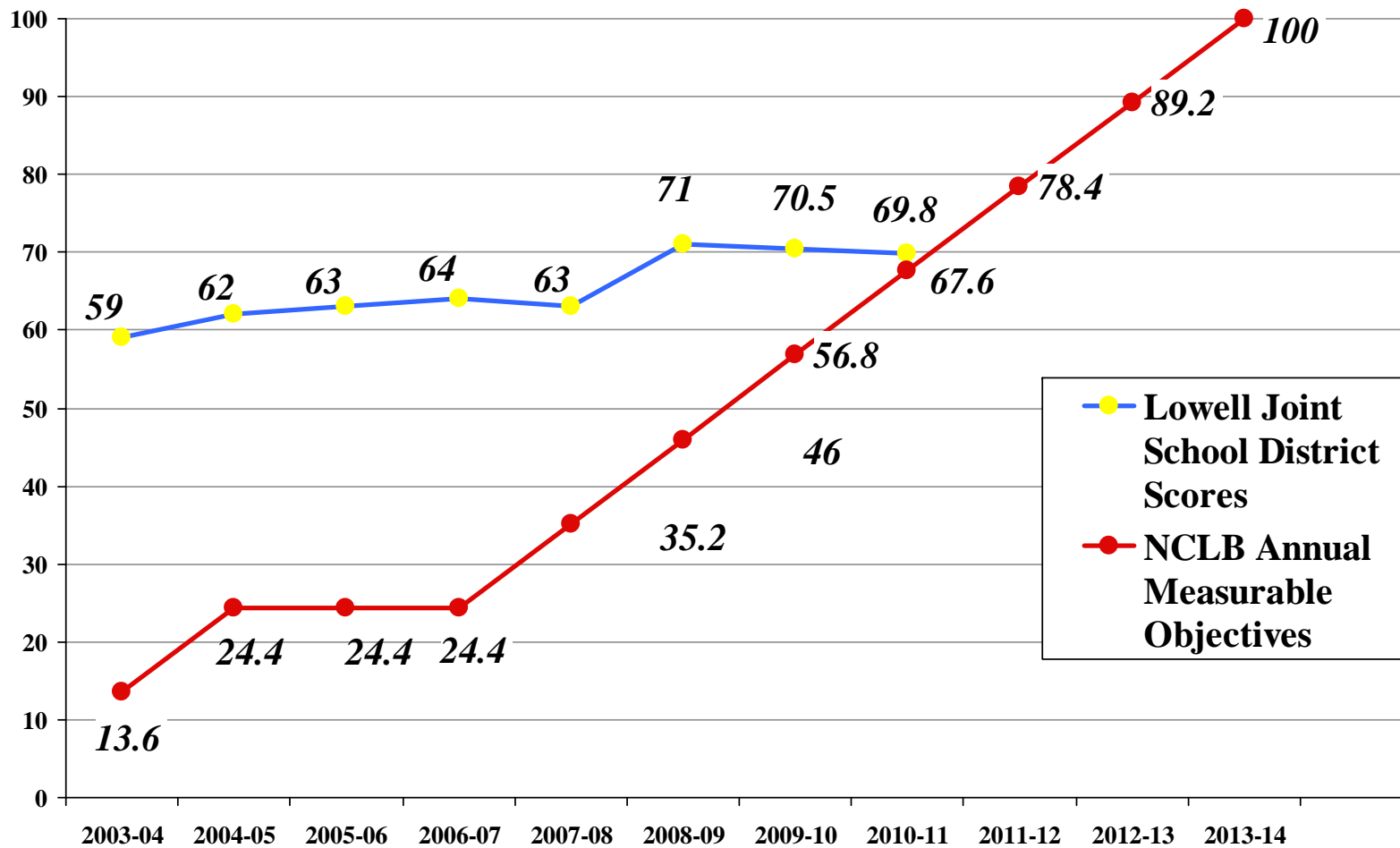

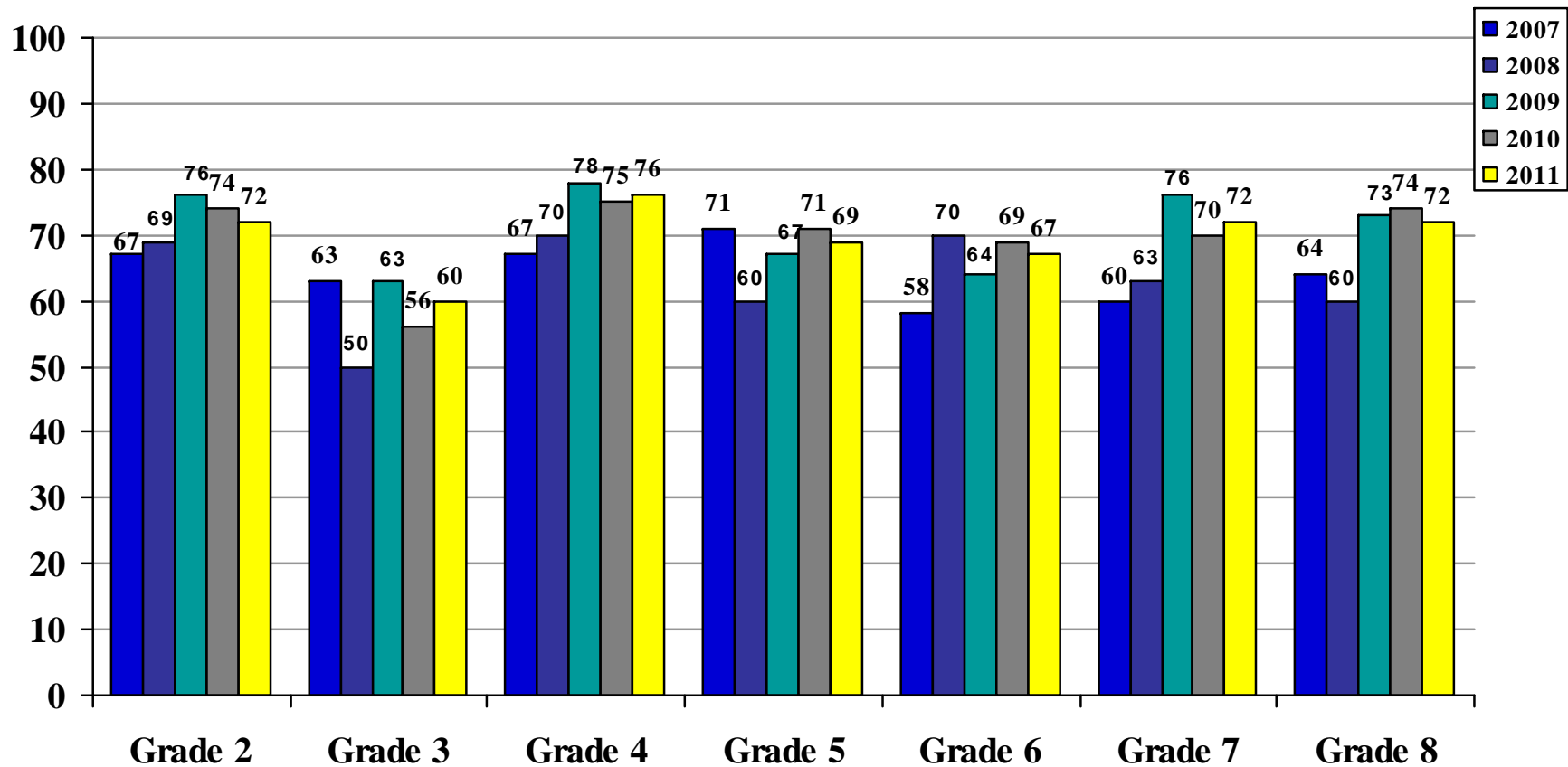

## CST Results – English/Language Arts

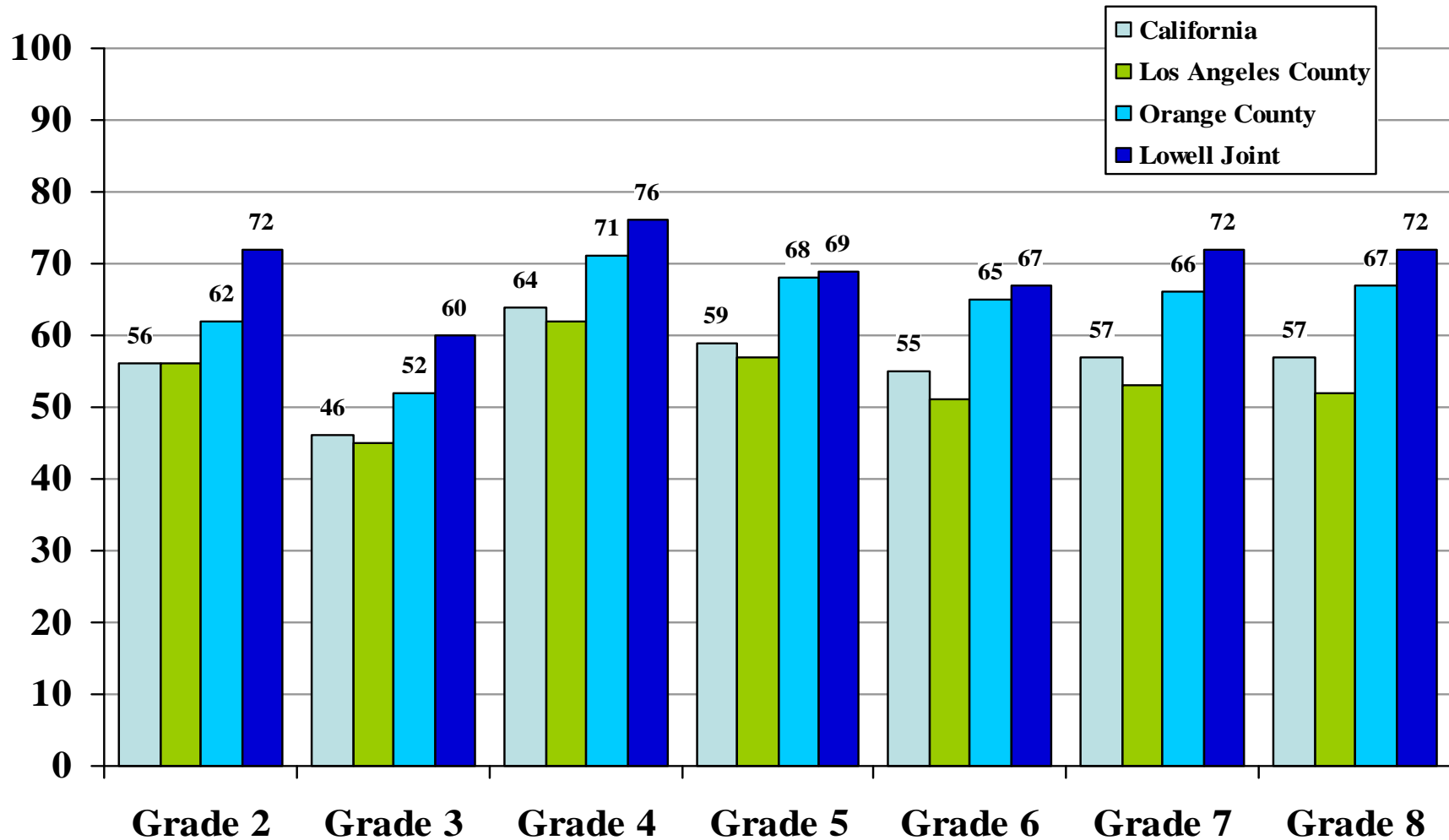
*Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient and Advanced*

*Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient and Advanced*



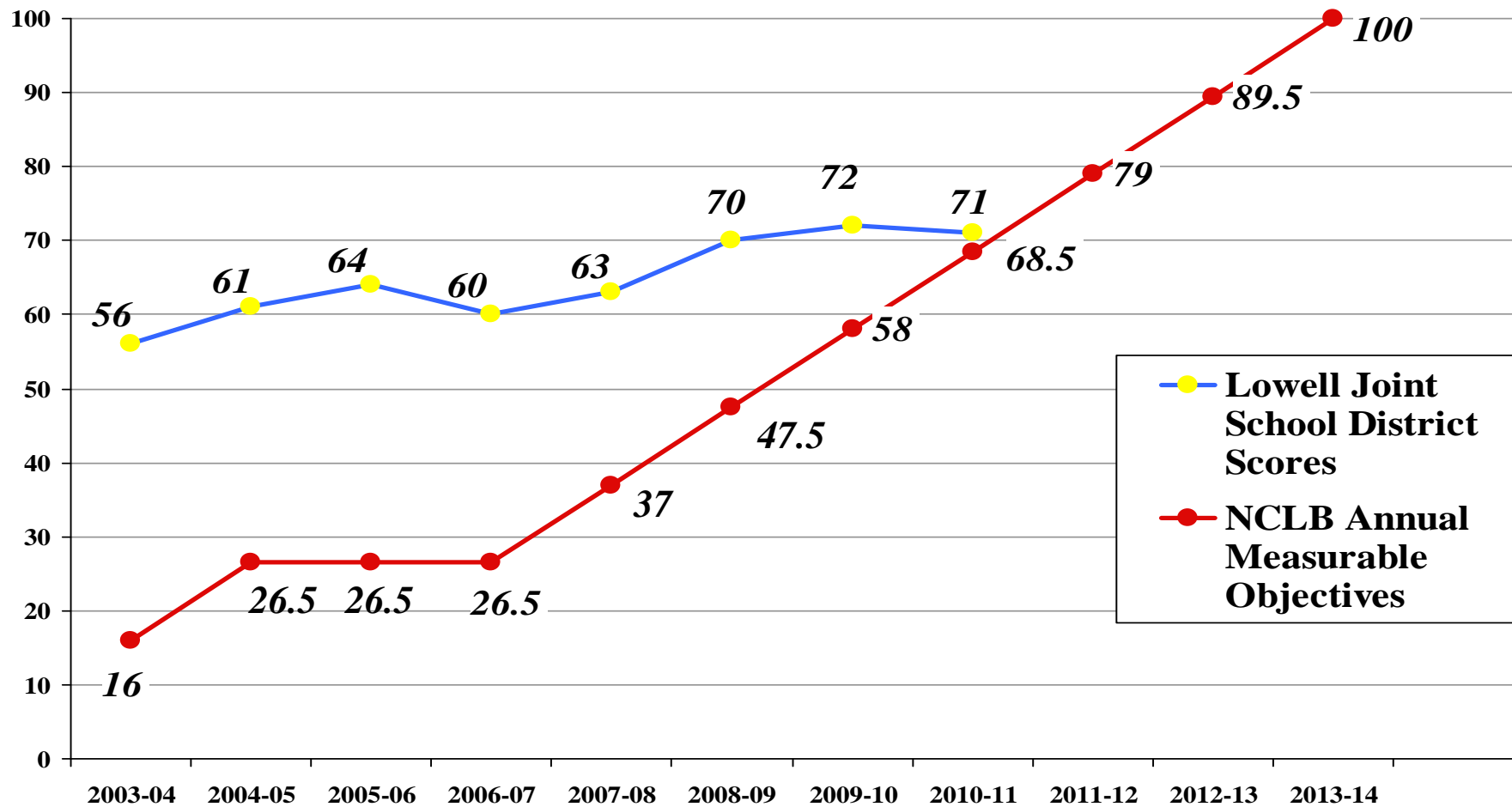

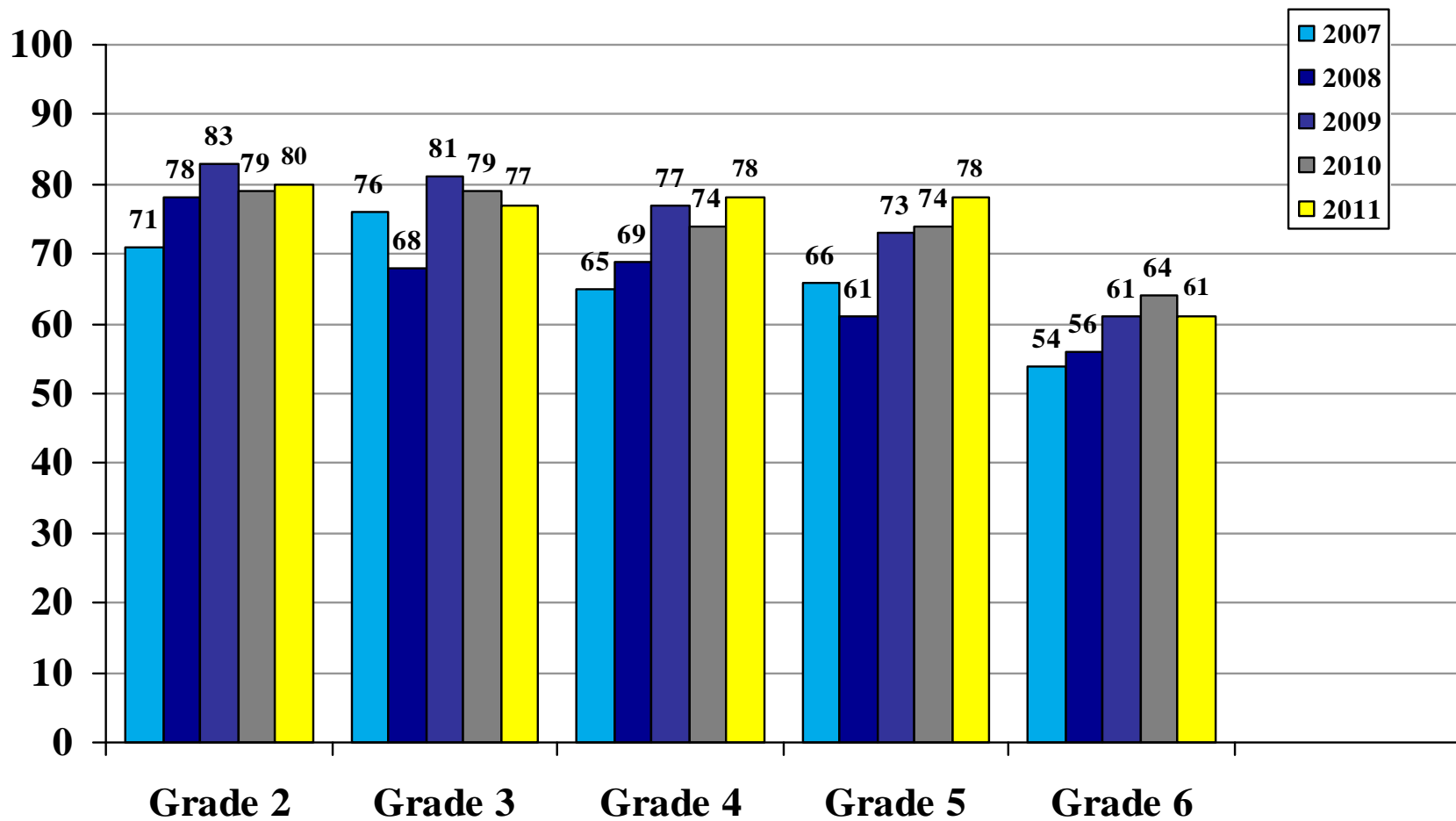

## CST Results - Mathematics

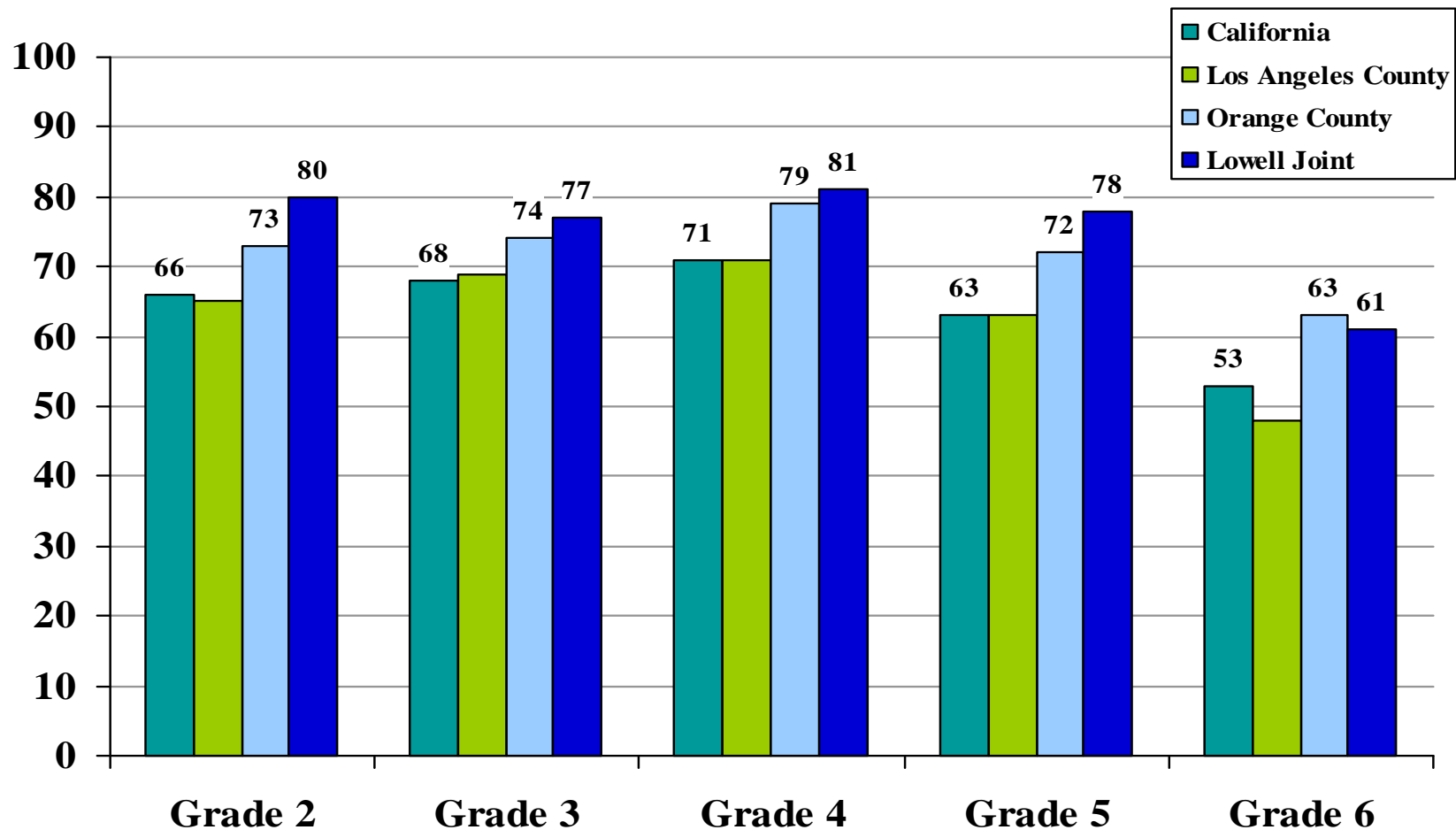
*Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient and Advanced*

*Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient and Advanced*

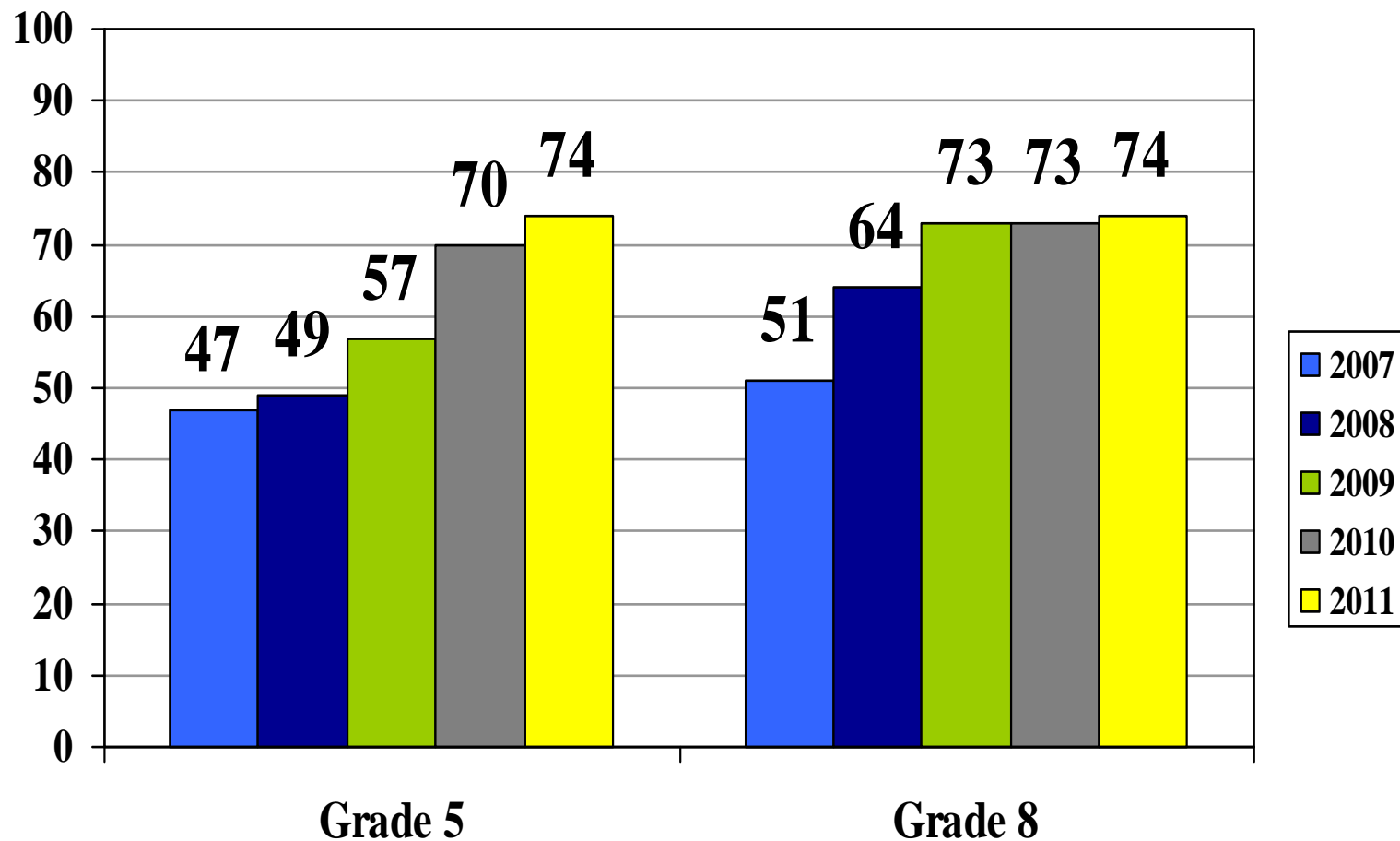

*Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient and Advanced*

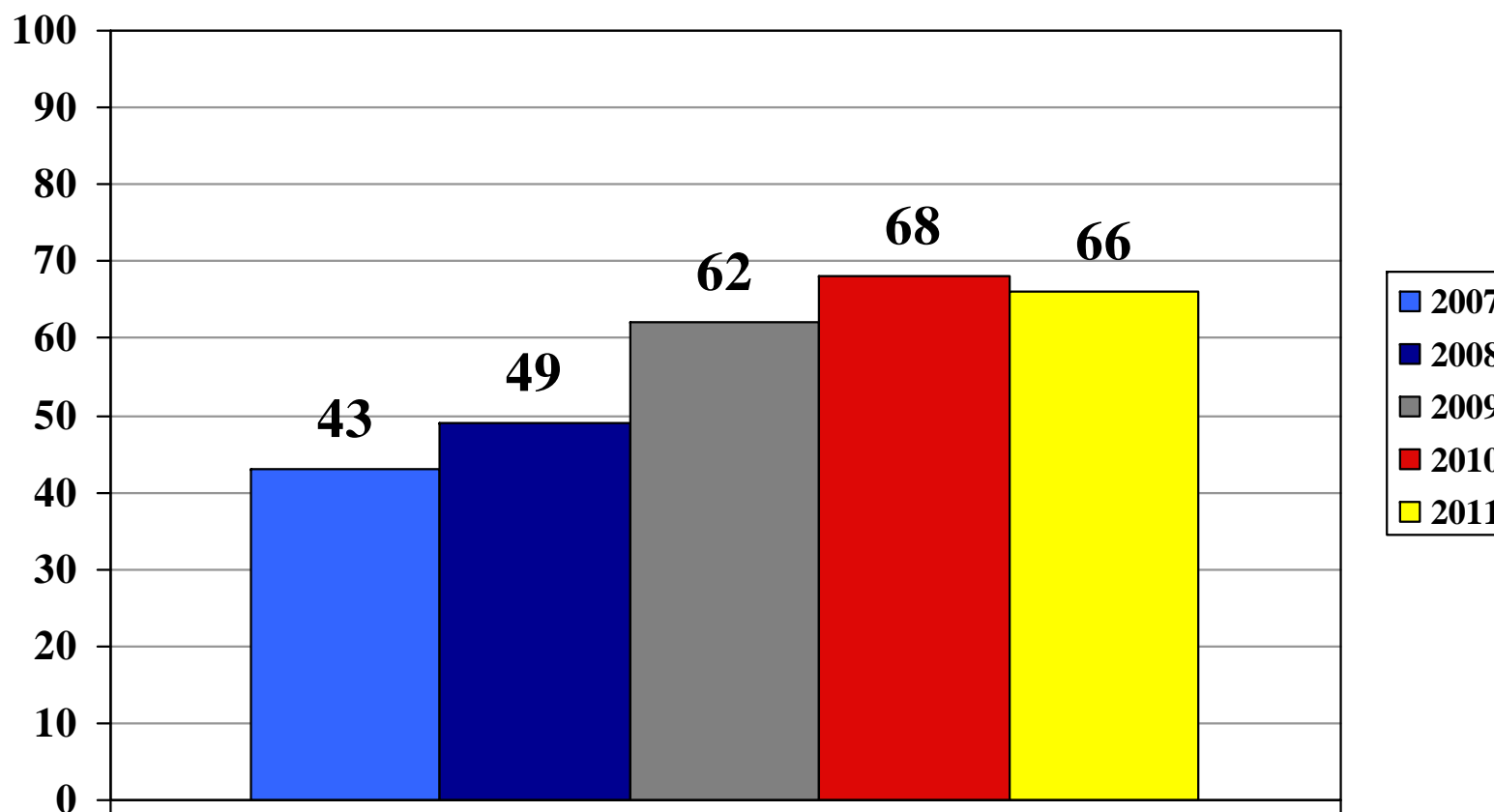

*Percentage of Students Scoring Proficient or Advanced*

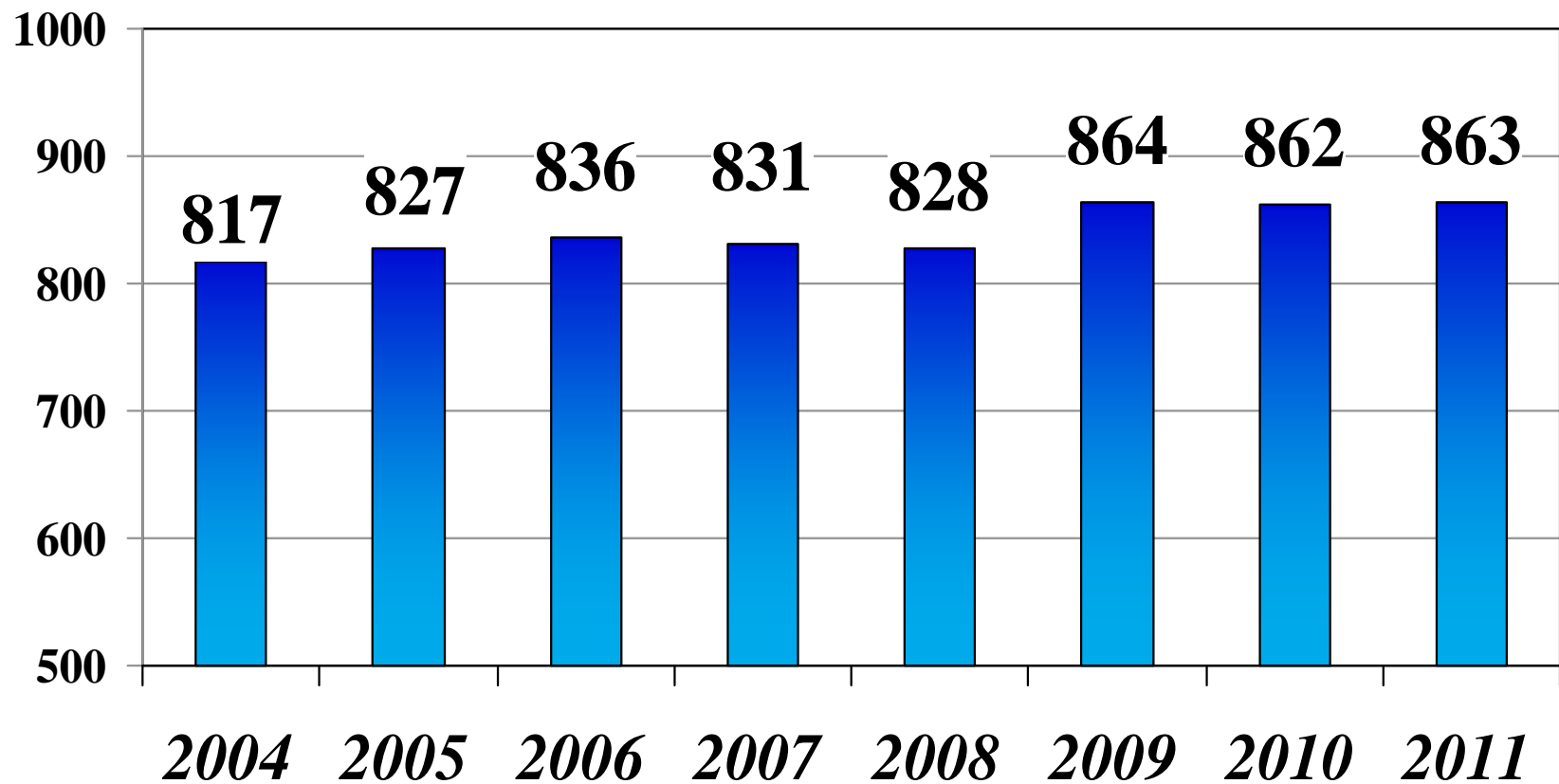

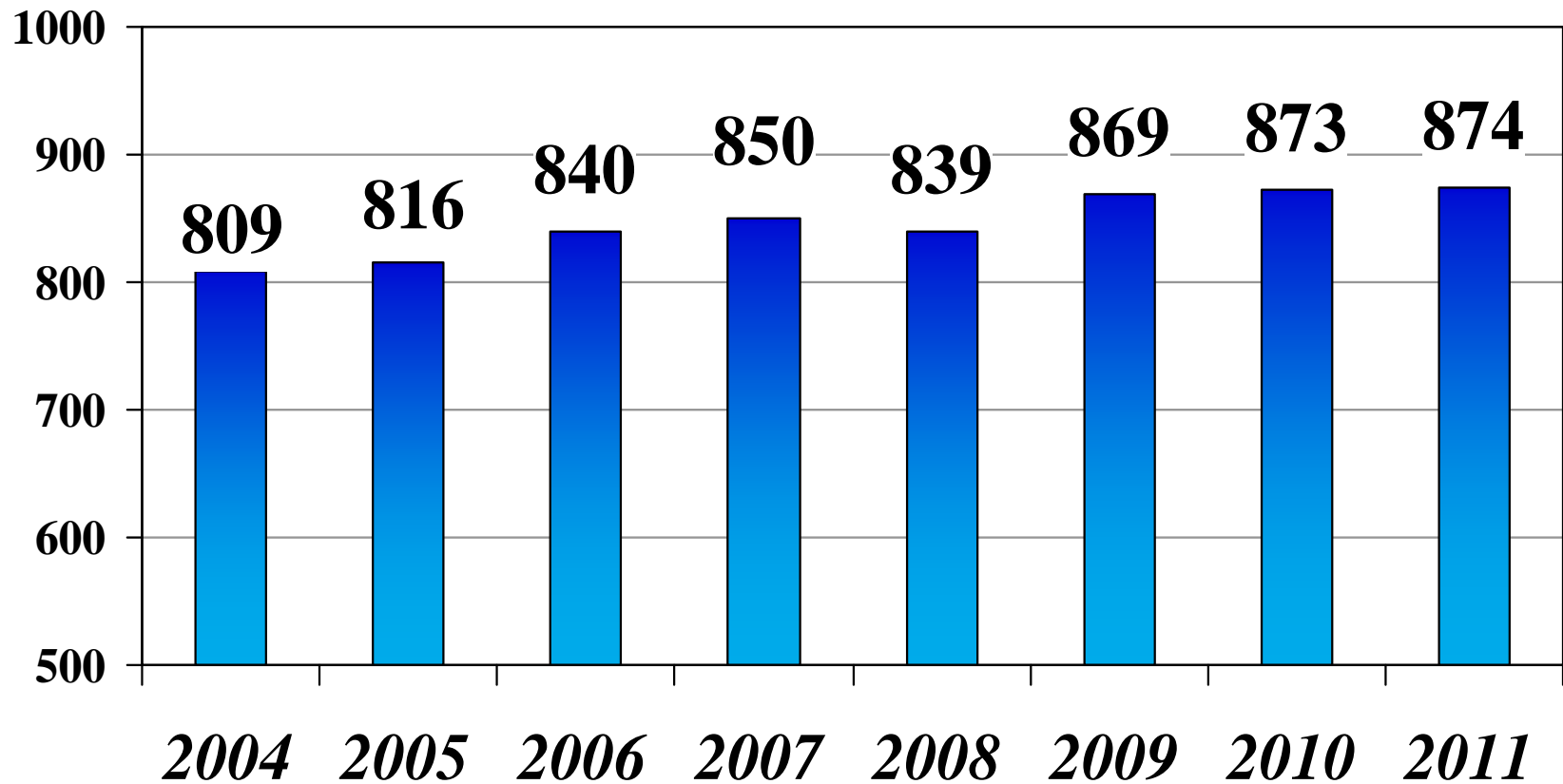

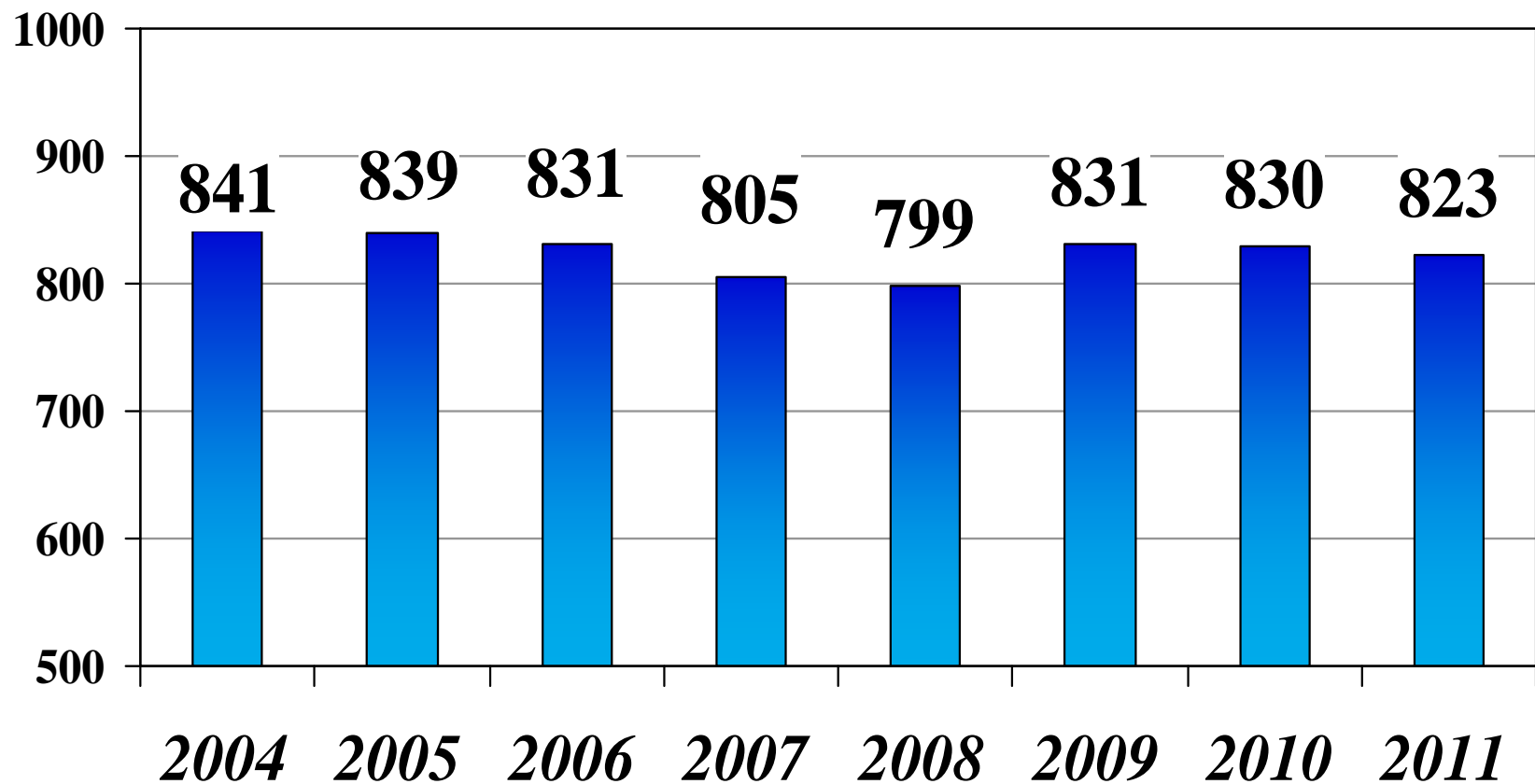

## Growth Academic Performance Index Results



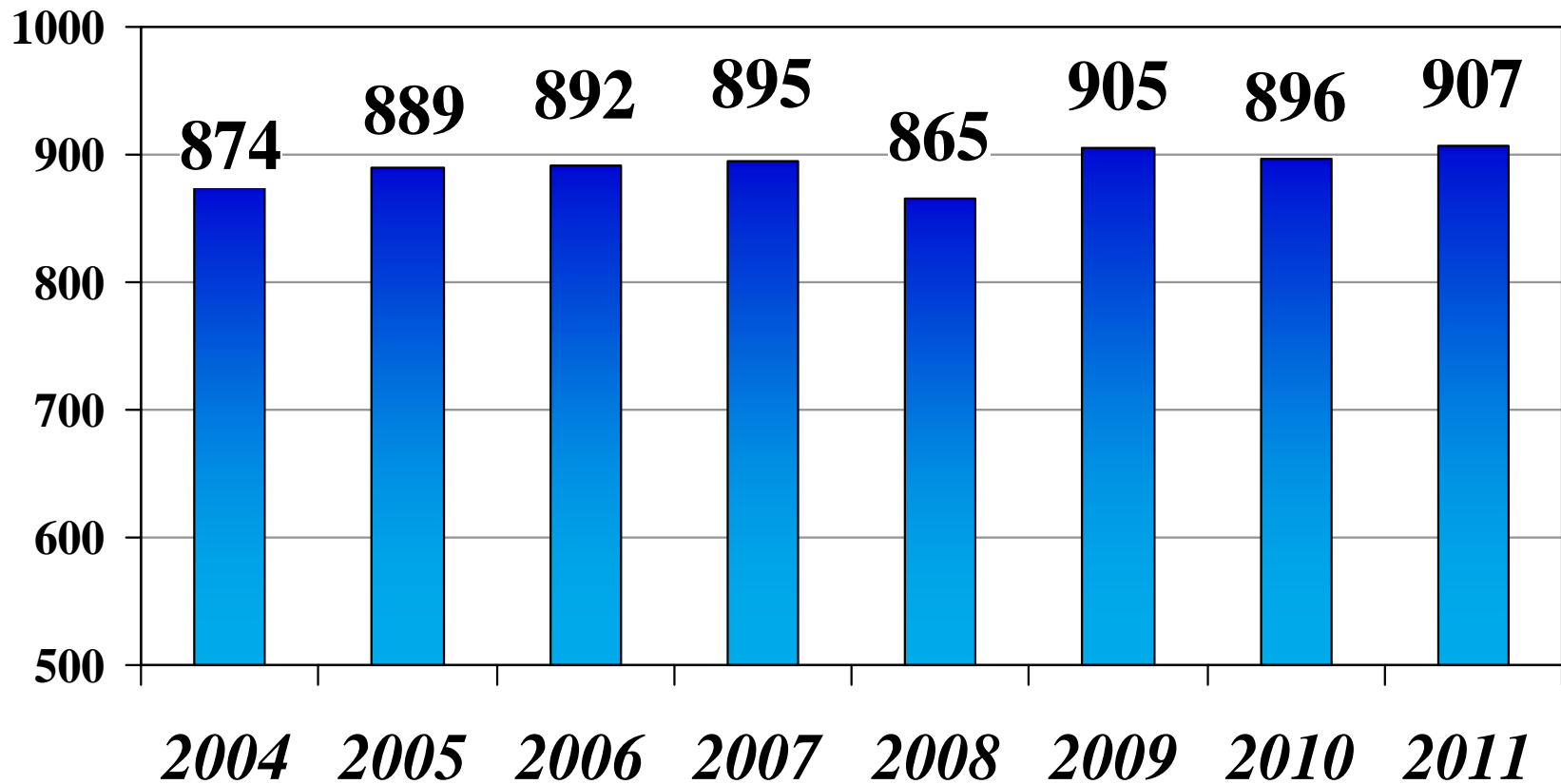

## Growth Academic Performance Index Results



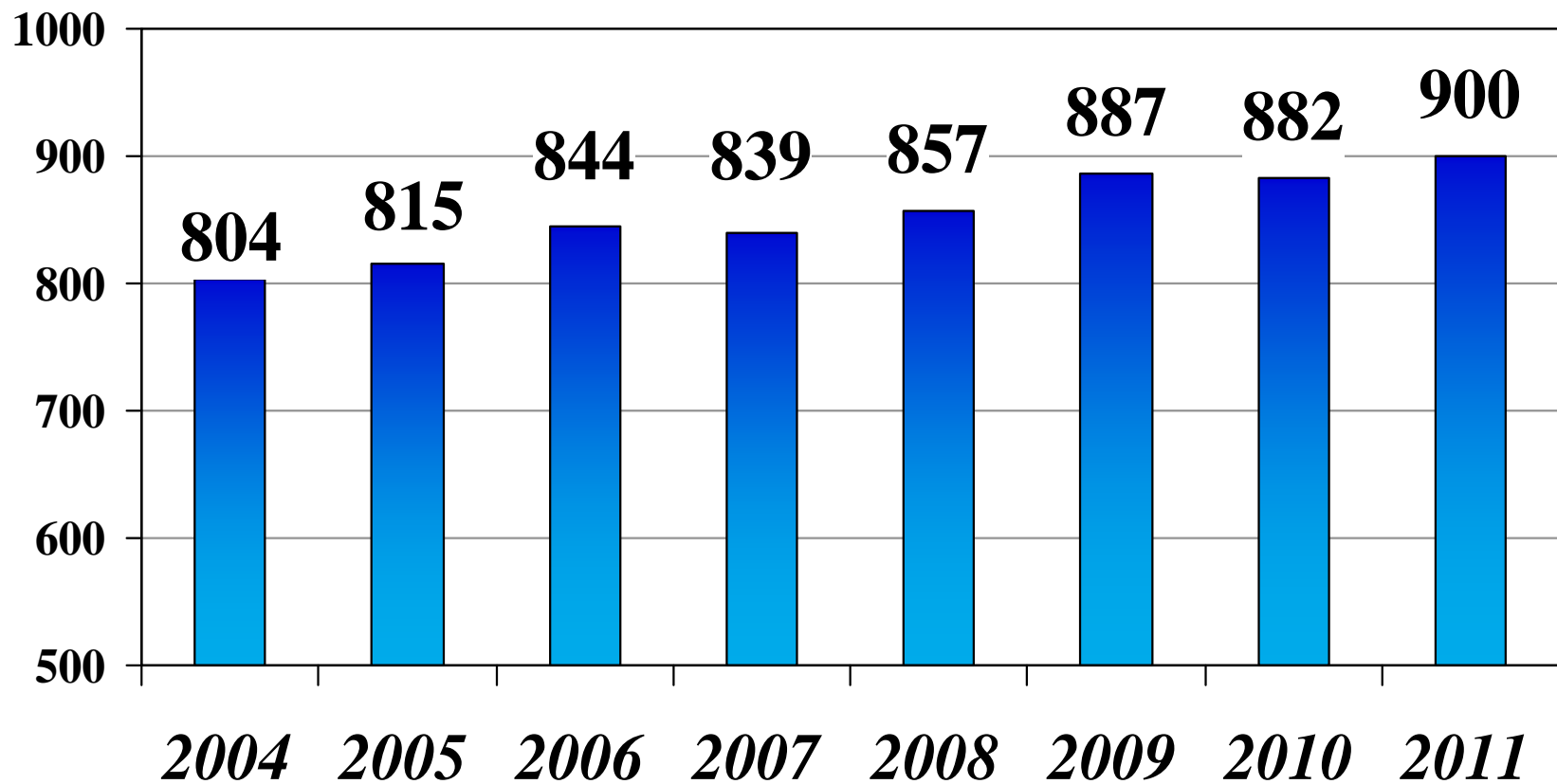

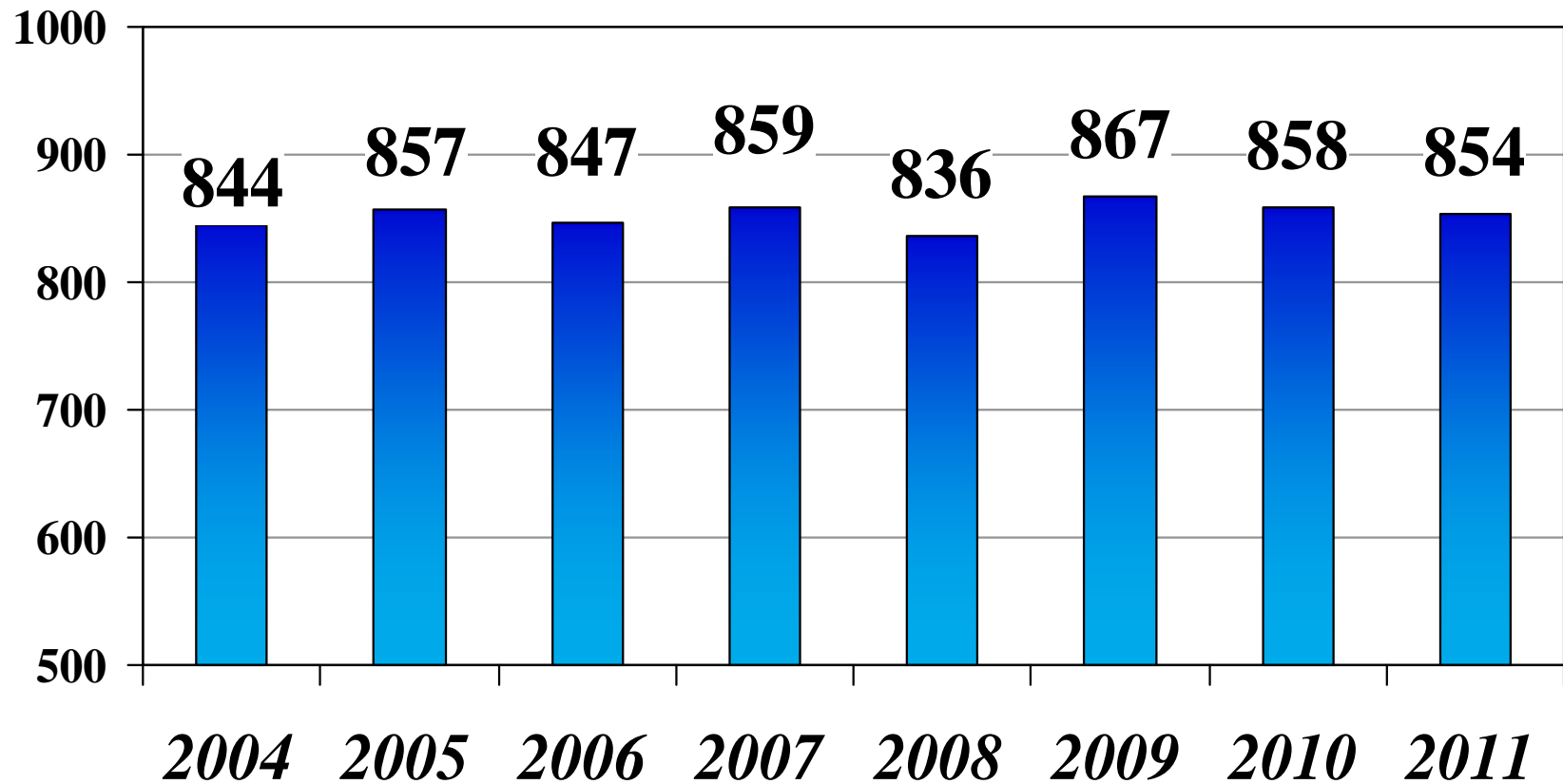

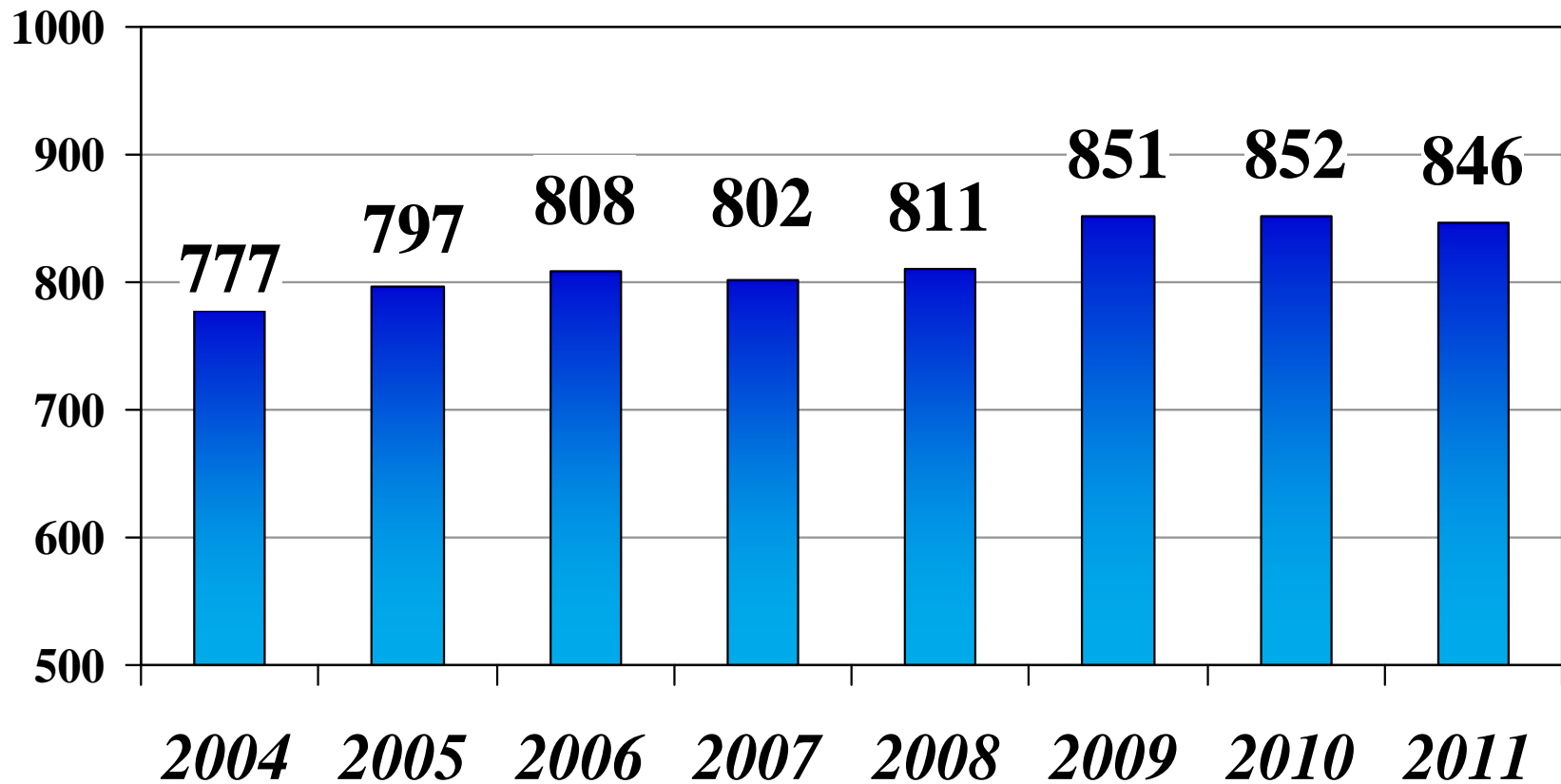

## Growth Academic Performance Index Results



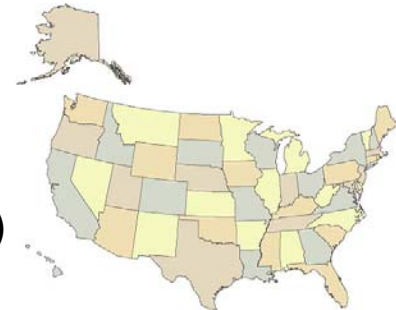

# ***Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP)***

- **Federal accountability reporting system**
- **Looks at the percentage of students meeting proficiency**
- **CST, CMA, and CAPA tests used to determine whether a district/school has met its AYP**
- **Criteria for meeting AYP**
  - **Participation rate of 95%**
  - **Percent proficient (ELA: 67.6% Math: 68.5%)**
  - **Additional API Indicator (710 or more)**
  - **Criteria must be met for students districtwide/schoolwide as well as significant subgroups**
