## MEADOW GREEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL ISSUES



**J-4:** STUDENTS THAT WALK TO SCHOOL CURRENTLY UTILIZE THE SMALL ALLEY AND GATES ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE SCHOOL. ACCESS FROM THE NORTH ALLOWS STUDENTS TO AVOID ON SITE TRAFFIC ASSOCIATED WITH THE PARKING LOT AND DROP-OFF BUT THE SMALL ALLEY IS NOT DESIGNED FOR PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC. GATES FROM THE ALLEY DO NOT PROVIDE AN IMPROVED POINT OF ACCESS AS STUDENTS NEED TO TRAVERSE A DIRT HILL TO ENTER THE SCHOOL. THE DESIGN FOR THE DROP-OFF SHOULD CONSIDER PEDESTRIAN ACCESS FROM THE NORTH AND SEEK TO IMPROVE THE ACCESS WITH STUDENT SAFETY IN MIND.
