- ★ District CST scores increased in every grade level in English/Language Arts and also increased in every grade level (except third grade which decreased one percentage point) in Mathematics.
- ★ Continued to implement Step-Up-To-Writing and 4th and 7th Grade CST Writing scores continue to increase at every school.

- ★ Began the planning process for the implementation of the Common Core Standards and trained Kindergarten and first grade teachers
- ★ Trained all teachers and administrators in Explicit Direct Instruction (EDI) classroom instructional strategies
- All schools offered before-school and/or after-school academic intervention classes

- Offered all-day Kindergarten at Jordan Elementary School
- ★ Maintained reduced class size in Kindergarten through 2nd grade
- Continued to utilize the MIND Institute ST Math Program at all six schools
- Implemented the Ticket To Read Program at all elementary schools

- Provided professional development training for teachers, classified staff members, and administrators
- Provided before- and after-school childcare program at Jordan, Macy and Meadow Green Elementary Schools
- Continued to provide character education and patriotic emphasis

★ Working with the Lowell Joint Education Foundation, offered after-school sports at Rancho-Starbuck Junior High School and hosted Academic Excellence Day

- ★ Redesigned the District's website and added websites for each of the schools
- Installed new computers and upgraded software at all of the school sites
- ★ Installed fiber optics from the District Office to each of the school sites to increase the bandwidth capabilities

Nutrition Services

- Added new healthy meal choices, including a wider variety of fresh fruits and vegetables for student lunches
- ★ Nutrition Services served 222,247
 lunches and 78,970 Grab & Go/Breakfast
 meals, ending the fiscal year with a
 positive budget balance for the fourth
 consecutive year

Maintenance of Facilities

- Repainted and recarpeted interiors of classrooms throughout the District
- ★ Completed over 2,000 work-order requests throughout the District in order to address safety issues and improve cleanliness in the classrooms and restrooms and installed a new fire alarm system at Olita Elementary School

- Working with architects, developed a Facilities Needs Assessment for the District
