- All schools received an 862 or above on the Academic Performance Index
 Rancho-Starbuck Intermediate was honored as a California Distinguished School
- The District achieved higher at every grade level in ELA and Math than Orange County, Los Angeles County, and the State on the CST tests

- Implemented the Common Core Standards in Kindergarten and first grade and trained second, third, seventh, and eighth grade teachers
- Continued emphasis on the use of Explicit Direct Instruction (EDI) classroom instructional strategies and provided EDI Coaches at each of the sites
- All schools offered before-school and/or after-school academic intervention classes

- Implemented the *Illuminate* system to assist teachers with data analysis and report cards and provided a Data Coach at each site

- Continued to implement Step-Up-To-Writing as the District writing program at all sites
 - Continued to utilize the MIND Institute ST Math Program at all six schools
- Provided Ticket to Read, Lexia, and DyNed reading programs at the elementary schools

- Provided before- and after-school childcare program at Jordan, Macy and Meadow Green Elementary Schools
- Continued to provide character education and patriotic emphasis
