- All schools received an 870 or above on the Academic Performance Index
- Meadow Green Elementary School was honored as a California Distinguished School
- All schools were recognized as Honor Roll Schools by the California Business of Education Excellence
- Implemented the Common Core Standards in Kindergarten through 3rd grade and 7th and 8th grades, and trained 4th through 6th grade teachers

- ★ All students in 3rd through 8th grade participated in the Smarter Balanced online pilot assessment
- Continued emphasis on the use of Explicit Direct Instruction (EDI) classroom instructional strategies and provided EDI Coaches at each of the sites
- All schools offered before-school and/or afterschool academic intervention classes
- Assemblies focusing on bullying were provided at all six schools

- Implemented the *Illuminate* data system to assist teachers with data analysis and report cards and provided a Data Coach at each site
- Continued to implement Step-Up-To-Writing as the District writing program at all sites
- Continued to utilize the MIND Institute ST Math Program at all six schools and Lexia and DynEd reading programs at the elementary schools
- Continued to provide character education and patriotic emphasis
- Gathered staff and parent input in developing the new Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP)

- Provided professional development training for teachers, classified staff members, and administrators
- Provided before- and after-school childcare program at Jordan, Macy, Meadow Green, and Olita Elementary Schools
- Working with the Lowell Joint Education Foundation, offered after-school sports at Rancho-Starbuck Intermediate School, provided technology grants for all schools, and hosted Academic Excellence Day and the Fine Arts Extravaganza

- Updated the District's website and websites for each of the schools
- Installed new computers and upgraded software at all of the school sites
- Installed VoIP telephone system throughout the District

Nutrition Services

- Added new healthy meal choices, including a wider variety of fresh fruits and vegetables for student lunches

- Installed new security gates at the schools
